Directions to Dakota County Gun Club: Rosemount MN.

Coming From The:

North:

Go South on 35W to Exit #86, (Co Rd. 46), just past Buck Hill. Follow East until Highway 3. Turn South (right) until 170th St. turn East (left) for 3 miles. Turn South (right) for .6 miles. Turn left into Dakota County Gun Club driveway.

South:

Hwy 3 North until 170th St. Follow the above directions.

OR

Go North on Highway 52 until 160th Street or County Road 46 go West (left) until you come to Highway 3. Highway 3 will be your first stoplight. Turn South (left) and follow to 170th St. Follow the above directions.

While the posted speed limit is 40MPH on 170th St East of Highway 3, we ask you honor the Gun Club self-imposed limit of 30 MPH. If the roads are dry and dusty, we ask that you please slow down even more as you pass by farm, houses and buildings.

Please do not drive on Station Trail South of 170th go East to Annette then South to our gate
